

Instructor Candidate Eligibility

In order to qualify for WMSP, MSF RiderCoach, and/or ESC S/TEP instructor training, candidates must have an acceptable driving record as outlined below.

The DOL Director retains the authority to examine the current and past driving record of any candidate to determine if admission into an Instructor Preparation (IP) course should be granted.

Candidates' driving records must reflect:

- No more than 3 moving traffic infractions within the preceding 12 months, and no more than 4 moving traffic infractions in the preceding 24 months.
- No alcohol or drug-related traffic violations within the previous 5 years.
- No driver license suspensions, cancellations, revocations, or denials within the preceding 3 years.

Other prerequisites are that candidates must:

- Be an experienced motorcyclist who owns and regularly operates a registered motorcycle, side-car, or trike that complies with all applicable vehicle laws and codes.
- Possess a current and valid driver license with a motorcycle endorsement.
- Be a high school graduate, or equivalent, and be at least 21 years of age.
- Have no felony convictions.
- Have successfully completed a novice rider course (2-wheel candidate), or basic S/TEP course (3-wheel candidate), within 12 months of the IP.
- Have reviewed and agree to sign the Standards and Responsibility form.
- Have attended a candidate orientation workshop within the last 12 months.
- Review, sign, date, and return an instructor application no later than 45 days prior to the IP of interest.
- Have successfully completed training in both first aid and CPR, as evidenced by including current certifications (e.g. completion cards).
- Review, sign, date, and submit a Candidate Registration form, along with the \$200 tuition fee, (at least) 30 days prior to your IP of interest.
- Maintain current/valid e-mail and mailing addresses with WMSP.

Once received, and all eligibility requirements are verified, an invitation to attend an IP will be sent to the candidate electronically. Pre-course assignments and curriculum materials will then be mailed.

IPs are limited to a maximum attendance of 16 candidates. Invitations are sent out based upon candidate interest and receipt of required paperwork.
